All Funeral Directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different Funeral Directors because prices can vary.

ATTENDED FUNERAL (Subtotal of Funeral Director's charges only)	£1751.00
Breakdown of costs below:	
<i>This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.</i>	
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements.	£850
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the Funeral Director's premises) into the Funeral Director's care.	£150
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at a Funeral Director's premises.	£150
Providing a suitable coffin (oak veneer).	£320
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the Funeral Director (I have to legally show a cost here, however no charge is made).	£1
At a date and time you agree with the Funeral Director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the Funeral Director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle.	£280
UNATTENDED FUNERAL (DIRECT BURIAL/CREMATION)	
<i>Family and friends do not attend the cremation or burial, however may choose to have a ceremony, event or service, arranged by themselves, for the deceased person without the coffin being present.</i>	
Unattended Burial (Funeral Director's charges only).	£1050

<p>Third Party Fees You Must Pay</p> <p>For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee.^[1] In this local area (Newcastle/North Tyneside) the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is:</p> <p>For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.</p>	£1014 - £2028

[\[1\]](#) This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

[\[2\]](#) In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
